# Game Odd one out

## Instructions

This can be played as a game or can be completed as an activity. You and your kids choose!

### **Materials Needed:**

Worksheet for each player  
Pen or pencil for each player

### **How to Play (Or Complete as Activity):**

1. Have kids read the words grouped for number 1. Working individually, have them circle the word that doesn't fit the group.  
For example: la casa doesn't fit the words in number 1 because the other words are rooms in the house.
2. Have students say which word they circled and explain why it's the odd one out.\*
3. Repeat steps 1 and 2 for the rest of the activity.

### **How to Win:**

If you're making it a game/competition, whoever has the most right answers wins. For a tie-breaker, you could have whoever has the best explanations of why words are the odd ones out.

There is an answer key on p. 3.

\*I am having my kids explain in English because they don't know much vocabulary yet and probably don't have enough to explain. However, if kids want to try and explain in Spanish, I wouldn't stop them!
