Instructions:

On the following page is an example of the story that the boys and I created together. I used the mini-story outline script from the Conversation Script and then typed it up for a story to read with them.

I formatted it one line at a time because that makes it easier for kids to read and understand.

You can use this for both listening and reading practice. When I read stories with my students, I read a sentence in Spanish and then have students act out the story or draw it while I'm reading so they can show understanding. Feel free to say the sentence as many times as they need to hear it!

You can either tell the kids what the bolded words mean in English as you go or write the words on the vocabulary list.

If you feel like your kids have had enough listening practice from other listening activities and easily understand what you're saying in Spanish, feel free to just have them read the story.

A. Read each sentence of the story first in Spanish and then in English.

Dino pasa mucho tiempo con Saur.

Un día, Dino está en **una calle** en Canadá.

Dino piensa: *Me gusta jugar con Legos y quiero ir a la casa de Saur para jugar con Legos.*

Dino le dice a Saur <<Quiero jugar con Legos **contigo**>>

Saur le dice a Dino <<**Yo también**>>

Dino necesita ir a la casa de Saur para jugar con Legos porque Saur tiene un billón de Legos.

Dino camina a la casa de Saur.

Dino llega a la casa de Saur y espera a Saur por un minuto.

Dino piensa: *Estoy contento porque me gusta jugar con Legos con Saur.*

Saur no llega a su casa porque **un extraterrestre** lo toma al planeta del extraterrestre.

Después de diez minutos, Dino piensa: *¿Dónde está Saur?*

Dino está triste.
