Copy of puzzle pieces on p. 2*

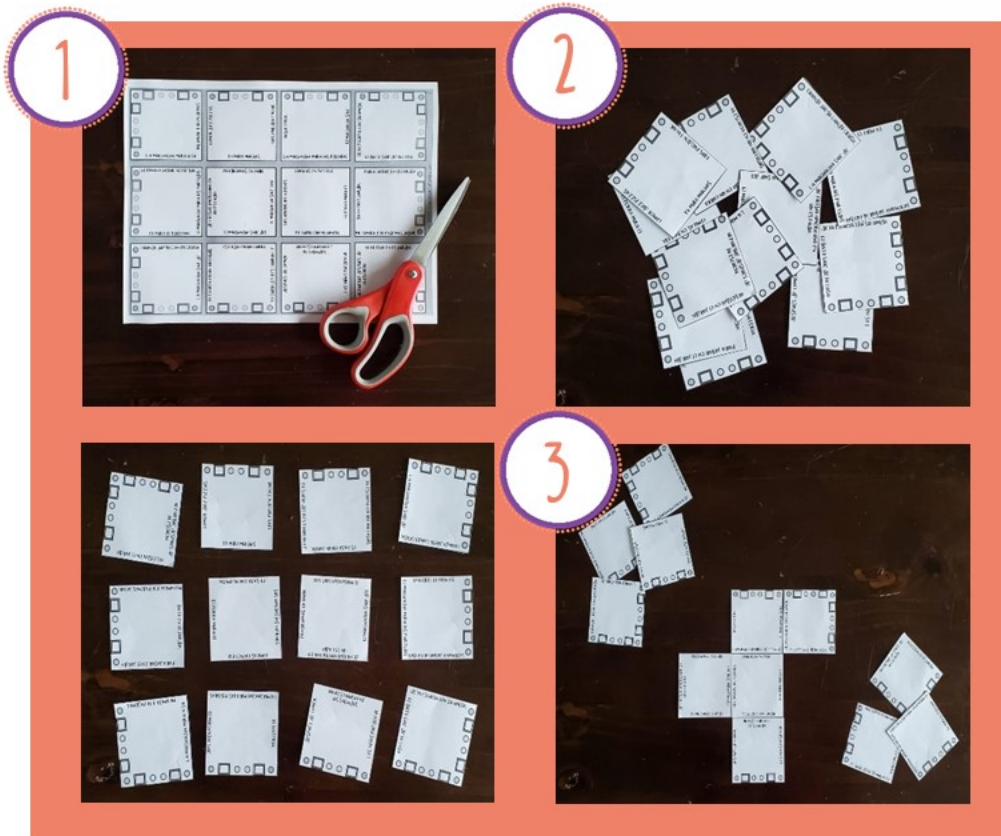
Set-up:
