Instructions:

On the following page is an example of the story that the boys and I created together. I used the mini-story outline script from the PQA document and then typed it up for a story to read with them.

I formatted it one line at a time because that makes it easier for kids to read and understand.

You can use this for both listening and reading practice. When I read stories with my students, I read a sentence in Spanish and then have students act out the story or draw it while I'm reading so they can show understanding. Feel free to say the sentence as many times as they need to hear it!

You can either tell the kids what the bolded words mean in English as you go or write the words on the vocabulary list.

If you feel like your kids have had enough listening practice from other listening activities and easily understand what you're saying in Spanish, feel free to just have them read the story.

A. Read each sentence of the story first in Spanish and then in English.

Hay un papagayo¹.

Él se llama Cheez-it.

Cheez-it es anaranjado, blanco y enfadoso².

Cheez-it vive en la selva.

Cheez-it no tiene un amigo pero tiene un avión pequeño.

Un día, Cheez-it está en su casa en la selva.

Cheez-it quiere un amigo y quiere comer muchos Cheez-Its.

Hay muchas plantas con Cheez-Its en la selva.

Cheez-it necesita ir donde están las plantas.

Cheez-it sube a su avión y va donde están las plantas.

Cuando Cheez-it llega, él baja del avión y ve las plantas con Cheez-Its y a otro³ papagayo.

Cheez-it piensa: *¡Hay otro papagayo!*

Cheez-it está contento y le dice <<¡Hola!>> a otro papagayo.

De repente⁴, una persona toma Cheez-it y al otro papagayo y los pone en una jaula⁵.
