Instructions:

On the following pages are vocabulary worksheets which have a list of the vocabulary for the two lessons about the airport. This worksheet has Spanish with English translations. Kids can use this to look for words when completing the activities.

My suggestion is to make a copy for each person.

There is also a vocabulary page with helpful "small" (but very important) words that aren't officially taught, but kids will learn over time. I have a word wall with these in my classroom, and kids learn the words quickly because they are repeated so much. If you don't have a word wall like described [here](#), print the list on slide 5.

Grammar Notes:

Here are the infinitives of the verbs for these lessons:

oír - to hear

ir a inf. - going to ...

Ir a inf. is a phrase to describe what is going to happen in the near future. You replace the *inf.* with a Spanish infinitive.

For example:

Poco va a comer una pizza mañana.

Poco is going to eat a pizza tomorrow.

Comer is the infinitive in the above example. I've included a list of infinitives that have been used in previous lessons on the vocabulary list. I also included *volar* since this lesson is based in the airport.

I've included both genders for the nouns for the people. Some nouns stay the same and only change the article. For example, *agente* and *policía* are the same for both men and women, but the article changes to *el* for a man and *la* for a woman.
