Chapter 3 - Airport

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Instructions for Airport Map

This can just be used for an arts and crafts type of activity but can also be used with the Total Physical Response (TPR) activity.

Materials:

- ❖ **Pictures of places and labels pp. 3 - 6** (if each kid is making a map, then 1 set of pictures per kid; if you are all working together to create one map, then just 1 set of pictures). Slide 7 is optional. I added a boy, a girl, a cat and 2 dogs if kids want to use the kids or animals for the TPR activity.
- ❖ **Coloring utensils** (colored pencils, crayons, markers, watercolor paints, etc.)
- ❖ **Poster board, foam board, or large piece of butcher paper.** I have found poster boards and foam boards at the dollar store.
- ❖ **Glue or tape**

Instructions:

1. Print pages 3 - 6 for the places. Print slide 7 if your kids want to use one of the kids or animals for the TPR activity.
2. Color the places. Color the kids or animals if using.
3. Cut out the places with or without the labels. If you use the TPR activity, then it will be good practice for them to hear the places without seeing the labels. But, if you think your kids need the labels then cut those out too. You can always cut out the labels separately so you can add them or remove them from the map.
4. Lay out the places on the poster board the way you want your airport to look.
5. Glue or tape the places onto the poster board. Glue or tape the labels onto the places if using labels. You could also use a reusable adhesive like Blu-Tack especially if you want to be able to remove the labels.
6. Cut out the kids or animals if using.

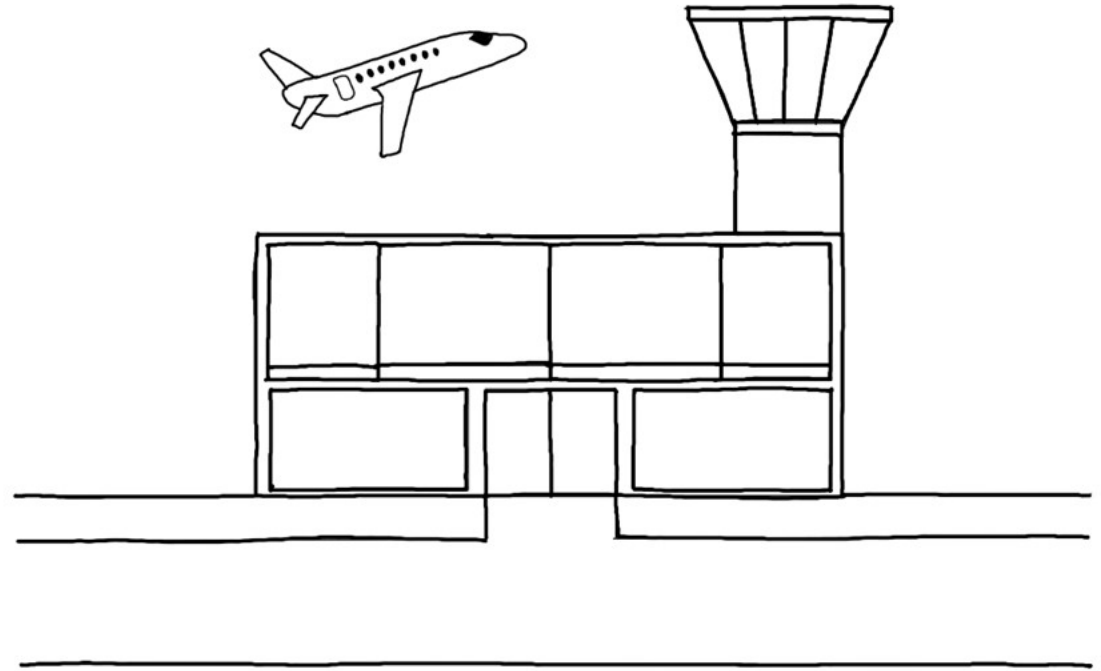
Optional:

If you're going to use the TPR activity, you could skip the poster board and make a really big map of the airport on the floor so kids could go from place to place (instead of using action figures or the animal/people cut outs).

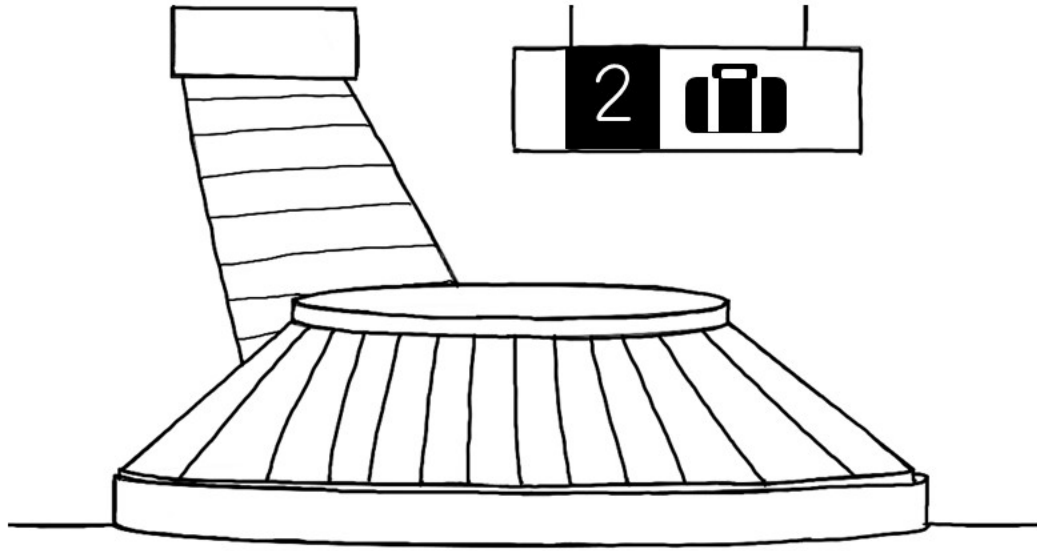
Just do steps 1, 2, and 3. After completing step 3, lay out the places on the floor in the way you want the airport to look and start the TPR activity.



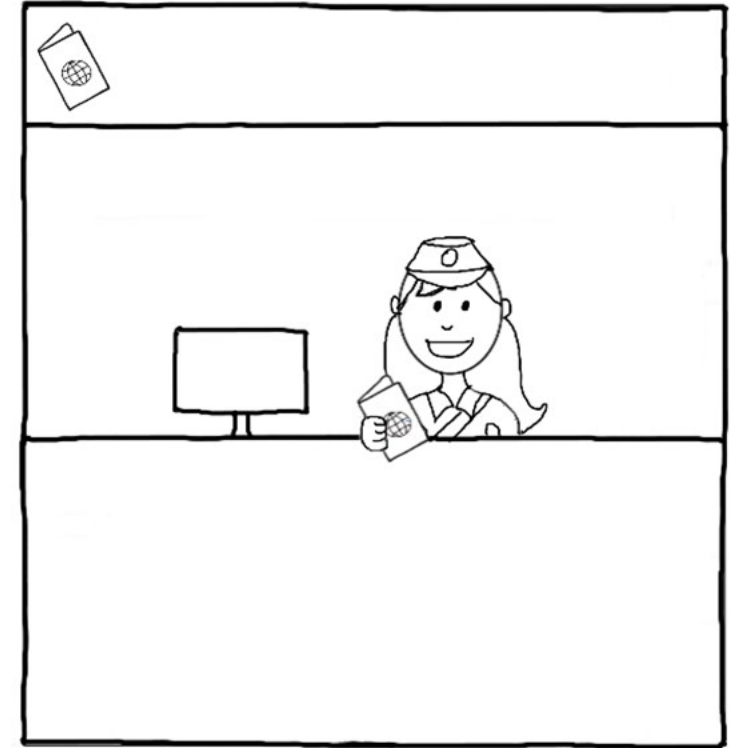
